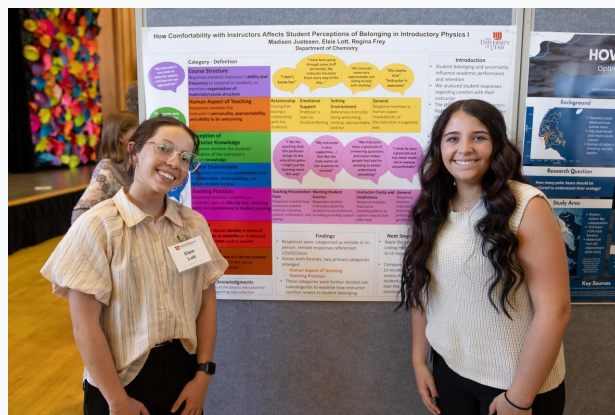

Matthew Wang, conservation program manager at the [Red Butte Garden](#) and Arboretum, is using high-resolution imaging technology to capture seeds in unprecedented detail.
